## MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: 36th Avenue W between 14th Street W & 9th St W

This correspondence is prepared as a continuation to the January 16, 1984 memorandum on the same subject. As you are aware, the Cedar Hammock Fire Department built a private road and bridge on their property with access to 9th Street West. In consideration for this location to be a future tie as a public road, the following must take place:

- A. The entire road must be brought up to county standards, such as 24 feet in width, ditch piping, access/decell lanes on 9th and 14th, etc. Estimated construction cost would be approximately \$160,000.
- B. Left turn lanes must be constructed at both intersections of 9th Street and 14th Street, estimated cost \$90,000.
- C. Signalization installed at the intersections of 9th Street West and 14th Street West, estimated total cost \$50,000.
- D. The removal of an existing aluminum arch bridge, which is for limited use only and would not be adequate for general public use. The replacement of the aluminum arch would be with 80 linear feet of triple 9' x 12' box culvert. Estimated cost is \$175,000.
- E. Additional right of way for intersection improvements. Additional right of way costs are approximately \$28,000.

The total estimated costs for construction, signalization, bridge and right of way is \$503,000.

Our appraisal of the desirability of having 36th Avenue West as a public road is as follows:

- 1) It would provide minor relief to existing ties between 9th Street West and 14th Street West.
- 2) Development in the area has limited ties between 9th Street and 14th Street. This would provide a corridor between 9th and 14th within the limited local area.

- 3) It can meet minimum safety requirements provided recommended alterations are made.

Drawbacks would be as follows:

- 1) Increased traffic through an existing residential neighborhood accustomed to very low volumes of traffic.
- 2) The existing maintained portion would require accelerated maintenance.
- 3) The roadway through the site is not built to current county standards, nor has it been inspected for acceptability in the maintained system.

We have investigated similar potential on 39th Avenue West and found the following costs:

39th Avenue West for 2 lane reconstruction.	A) \$160,000.
500 feet of box culvert in order to take curve out of 9th.	B) \$800,000.
Turn lanes @ 9th St. West & 14th St.	C) 90,000.
Signalization @ 9th St. & 14th Street	D) <u>50,000.</u>
<u>TOTAL:</u>	<u>\$940,000.</u>

The long term solution to this east/west connection would be:

- (1) 30th Ave West, which would open it up from 27th St. East to 26th Street West. (\$1,164,660)
- (2) To align 30th Ave. W at 14th St. W & 9th St. West with signals at both 14th St. and 9th Street West. (\$ 632,000.)

Construction of 36th Avenue West to minimum standards would put the following traffic impacts in this area. (See attached).

Based on the cost of bringing 36th Avenue to acceptable standards, the limited value to be received and the existing needs in our Capital Improvement Program, we do not recommend proceeding with developing 36th Avenue West as a public access road.

SUBJECT: 36th Avenue East

At the present time 36th Avenue East is a dead end road accessing 14th Street West (US 41) with an estimated 150 vehicle trips per day. If 36th Avenue West was to access 9th Street West we estimate that the average day traffic count would be approximately 4,300 vehicles per day with a peak hour traffic volume around 400 vehicles per hour.

This is based on improve at the intersection of 14th Street West (signalization) and from the known traffic count we have gathered on the roads in the area of the De Soto Mall.

The opening of 36th Avenue West from 14th Street West to 9th Street West will primarily create a driveway access for the Mall to 14th Street West (Business 41), as it will only connect those two streets and not create any major east-west type connector (i.e. 30th Avenue West from 27th Street East to 26th Street West).


Dear Mr. Chance:
