This letter constitutes the initial determination, as required by Title 20 CFR, Section 676.88(a), regarding audit report No. 04-4-160-03-345, covering grant No. 12-2-165-10, 12-2-165-48, 12-2-165-32, 12-2-165-27 and 12-2-165-05 between the United States Department of Labor (DOL) and Manatee County, hereinafter referred to as "the grantee."

The above-noted audit report questioned costs of \$5,557 which the grantee charged to the grant. Of those questioned costs, it is tentatively determined that \$5,557 are unallowable costs under the terms of the grant, applicable Federal regulations, or the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) of 1973, as amended. The enclosed Findings and Determinations (F&D) identifies each item of cost questioned in the audit report and notes the reasons for each determination to allow or disallow that item of cost.

The above-referenced audit report also identified certain "administrative findings," i.e., deficiencies in the grantee's management or financial controls, procedures, policies, or systems. The enclosed F&D identifies each administrative finding noted in the audit report and specifies the corrective actions, and associated deadlines, which the grantee shall take to remedy the deficiencies.

The determinations concerning questioned costs and administrative findings, as set forth in this initial determination, are subject to informal resolution, pursuant to Title 20 CFR, Section 676.88 (d). If this matter cannot be informally resolved and final agency action establishes the debt, the following corrective actions and/or sanctions shall be imposed.

1. Corrective actions regarding disallowed costs. The grantee shall make payment by check to the Department of Labor in the amount of costs disallowed in the final determination. This amount hereinafter shall be called "the debt."

The debt shall be considered delinquent if not repaid within thirty (30) calendar days after the final determination, whether or not that debt is under formal appeal. When the debt becomes delinquent, the Department of Labor will charge interest on the delinquent debt at a rate of interest determined by the Department's Office of Administration and Management. Interest will accrue (but not be collected) during the administrative appeal process.

2. Sanctions. In the event that the debt becomes delinquent (failure to pay the debt as set forth above), DOL will initiate appropriate collection action in accordance with the Federal Claims Collection Standards, 4 CFR, Sections 102-105.

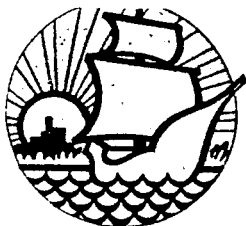
