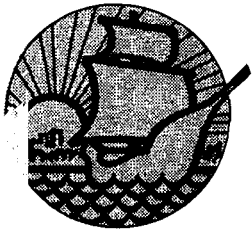

SUBJECT: Vacancy on Board: Housing Finance Authority

### BACKGROUND

The Housing Finance Authority Board was created to alleviate the shortage of housing and capital for investment in housing in Manatee County. This board has authority to issue bonds to provide for construction of housing for low and middle income families. The appointee must be filled by a permanent resident of Manatee County having knowledge in labor, finance or commerce. Two (2) vacancies that exist on the Housing Finance Authority Board must be filled. Terms about to expire are those of Mary K. Brownell who passed away on September 1, 1984 and Frank R. Dodson, III whose term expires on October 30, 1984.

### DISCUSSION

Frank R. Dodson, III has requested that favorable consideration be given to his reappointment as a member of the Authority for a four year term of office.

Letters of application for these positions are attached. A public notice was published in the local newspaper advertising the vacancy with a deadline to apply of October 8, 1984.

### RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of County Commissioners reappoint Mr. Dodson, III to another four year term on the Housing Finance Authority Board.

That the Board of County Commissioners appoint one member from the nominees listed below to serve on the Housing Finance Authority Board for a four year term, to expire on October 30, 1988.

Manatee County Ordinance No. 79-6, adopted July 17, 1979 by the Board of County Commissioners, created the Housing Finance Authority and provided for the appointment of members thereof by the Board of County Commissioners. The original members were appointed for staggered terms and thereafter all new appointments are for a term of four years. The Board of County Commissioners on October 30, 1979 adopted a Resolution Declaring the Need for the Housing Finance Authority of Manatee County, Florida to Function and Appointing the Members Thereof. Periodically thereafter, the Board of County Commissioners has adopted resolutions appointing or reappointing members of the Authority.

Mary K. Brownell and Frank R. Dodson, III were original members of the Authority and their current terms of office expire October 30, 1984.

Mary K. Brownell, who served both as Chairman and as Secretary of the Authority, died September 1, 1984. She was an active and loyal member of the Authority and her efforts and service on behalf of the Authority and the public are greatly appreciated. It is respectfully requested that a new member be appointed to both serve the unexpired term of Mrs. Brownell and for an additional four year term of office commencing October 30, 1984. It is suggested that this be handled by appointing a person knowledgeable in the fields of labor, finance or commerce for a term of office effective upon the date of appointment and terminating on October 30, 1988.


You advertised for information from persons interested in serving as members of the Housing Finance Authority in connection with the appointment of a member of the Authority on September 23, 1983, and it




