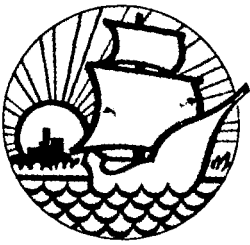

SUBJECT: Washington Park Borrow Pit

BACKGROUND

At its October 9, meeting the Board asked the County Administrator to determine MCPUDs interest in purchase of the Washington Park borrow pit.

DISCUSSION

In the past the Department had expressed concern over this property being purchased by Palmetto for use as a Class III disposal site. The initial investigation of utilization for this purchase made it appear unlikely that a permit could be granted for a Class III landfill. Very recent discussions with Pollution Control have indicated a better possibility.

If the property could be permitted for a Class III landfill, MCPUD would be interested in purchase in order to extend the useful life of the Lena Road landfill, a Class I facility.

It is estimated that 3 months and possibly more will be required for a positive determination. If the property cannot be used as a Class III landfill, MCPUD would have no other planned uses.
