Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and Project Proposal to which this Agency is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special conditions:

1. Manatee Mental Health Center, Inc. will provide supportive services to County case management staff. Such supportive services shall include, but not be limited to, technical assistance and in-service training. Such services shall be provided by the Manatee Mental Health Center, Inc. at no cost to the County.
2. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

MANATEE COUNCIL ON AGING, INC.

D. Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and Project Proposal to which this Agency is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special conditions:

1. The Agency shall develop a detailed action plan for adult day care services which shall, at a minimum:
 - a) outline steps to be taken to locate a site for a new day care center in Palmetto or Ellenton;
 - b) provide day care services at the new site no later than January 1, 1985, and if services have not been provided by January 1, 1985, a written explanation must be furnished to Manatee County Human Services Division by that date;
 - c) by October 31, 1984 identify steps and timeframes to provide services at G. T. Bray Adult Day Care Center which will improve client stimulation and functioning, and which will adequately document such.
2. Additional funds, in the amount of \$10,608 have been placed in a contingency account. These funds will be made available to Agency once Special Condition # 1 above has been met and approved in writing by the County.
3. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

EXHIBIT "A"

MANATEE ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS

Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and project proposal to which this is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special condition:

1. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

H.O.P.E. OF MANATEE, INC.

Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and Project Proposal to which this Agency is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special conditions:

1. Funds provided under this Agreement shall be used solely to support eligible services to eligible spouse abuse victims and their children (pursuant to Chapter 409 F.S. and Chapter 10A-8 F.A.C.) at the existing H.O.P.E. shelter location. Services to non-abused clients or services at outreach locations, as referenced in the Project Proposal, shall not be eligible for funding under this Agreement.
2. Agency shall continue to coordinate child abuse reports required by Chapter 827 F.S. with the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services. In order to document the incidence of child abuse, referrals (or reasons for no referral) shall be included in each client file.
3. Funding under this agreement is contingent upon continued progress in the implementation of recommendations generated by Dr. William Ewald's management study and the Agency's internal management improvement program.
4. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

EXHIBIT "A"

MANATEE OPPORTUNITY COUNCIL

Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and project proposal to which this Agency is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following conditions:

1. Day Care Programs shall maintain full compliance with licensure requirements as prescribed by state and local funding (and/or regulatory) agencies.
2. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

EXHIBIT "A"

MANATEE CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and Project Proposal to which this is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special conditions:

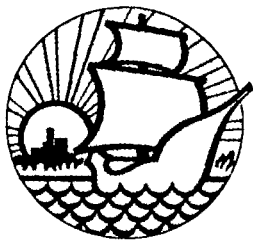
1. Funds provided under this Agreement shall be used solely to support house parent(s') salary at the existing shelter. Neither service nor salary of any other staff members, as referenced in the Project Proposal, shall be eligible for funding under this Agreement.
2. Agency shall continue to coordinate diagnostic evaluations, as recommended by the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, through designated referral protocol.
3. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.

HEALTH COUNCIL OF WEST CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC.

Project Special Conditions

In addition to the Agreement and Project Proposal to which this Agency is subject, the Agency is also subject to the following special conditions:

1. Agency shall coordinate planning and funding activities with the Manahill Area Agency on Aging and the District Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Planning Council through the continued development of a network of providers serving the high-risk elderly in Manatee County.
2. Agency shall review reports submitted to the County by the Manatee Memorial Hospital and Health System under the Agreement to Provide Reimbursement for Eligible Services to Qualified Individuals. Agency shall analyze and give technical assistance to the County at County's request regarding the administration of said Agreement.
3. Agency shall provide technical assistance to develop and implement the Public Health Unit Contract.
4. Agency shall provide technical assistance as requested by County concerning health planning issues.
5. Agency shall assist the County in conducting an assessment of handicapped accessibility in order to meet Federal handicapped accessibility requirements.
