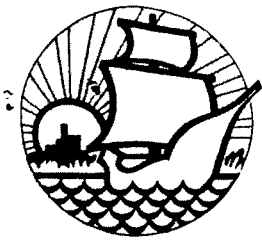

SUBJECT: Project No. 7032
Replacement of Jim Davis Bridge (#134009)

In accordance with the Board's direction to replace the Jim Davis Bridge with a similar structure, we contacted Harry Bertossa, Howard Needles Tammon and Bergendoff, who has done considerable bridge work for the County. Our question to them was could they save us sufficient money in the design of this bridge to pay their fee. He said that they had done a similar bridge on Santibel Island that ostensibly was to be used as a pedestrian bridge, but also to be sufficiently wide and strong to carry emergency vehicles. This was a timber pile structure. A bridge similar to this could be expected to cost between one hundred ten and one hundred thirty thousand dollars. The fee for the design preparation for plans, specifications, etc. would be somewhere between seven and eight thousand dollars. We also discussed the bridge with Dan Zoller, our overflow engineer. He felt that they had had considerable work in timber buildings but relatively small amount of work in timber bridges but they could do an excellent and economical job in the design for the bridge. Both engineers felt that consideration should be given to designing the bridge so it could be eventually enlarged to a two-lane bridge capable of carrying standard loadings.

Harry Ely the County Engineer has contacted Bill Kutash, Tampa Office of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, asking that they reconsider giving us a permit to establish a "Texas Ford" type concrete structure. He agreed to consider it as soon as we could submit the necessary plans. We will prepare those drawings for a permit application as soon as possible.

In the interim, request permission to advertise for a Request for Proposal for the necessary plans and specifications to replace the single lane, timber pile bent bridge on Jim Davis Road with a similar bridge that can eventually be modified to meet "Green Book Standards" for HS-20 loading. Further request that Central Services be authorized to reduce the advertising time to 14 days.
