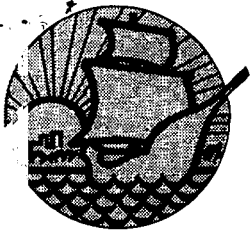

SUBJECT: Resolution 84-138 Antitrust Immunity Legislation

### BACKGROUND

In that Sarasota County has prepared a similar Resolution in an effort to influence Federal Legislative changes in the area of anti-trust damages assessed against political jurisdictions, we are in agreement with such Resolution, and urge adoption in Manatee County.

### DISCUSSION

The United States Senate Committee on the Judiciary has noted that during the past two years more than one hundred (100) federal anti-trust suits seeking treble damages are now pending against cities, counties, townships and virtually every other type of local government. In order to alleviate such suits in the future, we seek to develop legislation on a federal level that will grant antitrust immunity to local governments.

### RECOMMENDATION

We strongly urge adoption of Resolution 84-138 (Antitrust Immunity Legislation) based on the above information.
