BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MANATEE COUNTY

WHEREAS, a copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners and the Property Appraisers and Tax Collectors in Sarasota and Manatee Counties, Florida and with the Florida Department of Revenue, levying a 1.2743 mill ad valorem tax, which does not exceed the rolled-back rate on properties within the Town of Longboat Key, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF LONGBOAT KEY:

Section 1. In accordance with the Charter of the Town of Longboat Key, the Town Commission does hereby levy a .2852 mill ad valorem tax for the calendar year 1984 on all non-exempt real and personal property located within the Town of Longboat Key for payment of principal and interest on the outstanding general obligation water and sewer bonds of the Town of Longboat Key, Florida. The funds thereby received therefrom shall be deposited in the sinking fund of the general obligation bonds for the purpose of meeting the interest and principal payments of said outstanding general obligation water and sewer bonds of the Town of Longboat Key, Florida, for the year ending September 30, 1985 and the same is hereby appropriated for such purpose.

Section 2. In accordance with the Charter of the Town of Longboat Key and Section 218.23, Florida Statutes, the Town Commission does hereby levy a 1.2743 mill ad valorem tax, which does not exceed the rolled-back rate for the calendar year 1983 on all non-exempt real and personal property located within the Town of Longboat Key, and that the funds to be received therefrom shall be deposited into the general fund for the purpose of meeting the expenses and expenditures of the budget adopted for the Town of Longboat Key for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1984 and ending September 30, 1985, and the same is hereby appropriated for such purposes.

Section 3. The total millage for the Town of Longboat Key for the calendar year 1984 shall be 1.5595 mills.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 200.065(5), Florida Statutes, each taxing district may adjust its adopted millage rate if the taxable value within the jurisdiction of the taxing authority as certified is at variance from the taxable value shown on the roll to be extended; the adjustment shall be such that the taxes computed by applying the adopted millage rate against the certified taxable value are equal to the taxes computed by applying the adjusted adopted rate to the taxable value on the roll to be extended and the Town Manager of the Town shall certify to the property appraisers the Town's adjusted adopted rate.


Section 5. Copies of this Ordinance shall be furnished the Board of County Commissioners of Sarasota and Manatee Counties, Florida, the Property Appraisers and Tax Collectors of Sarasota and Manatee Counties, Florida, and to the Florida Department of Revenue for their immediate attention.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon second reading in accordance with law, and the Charter of the Town of Longboat Key.


RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 16 and 17 of Chapter 25688, Laws of Florida, 1947, as amended, and Chapter 200 F.S., as amended, it became the duty of the Board of Commissioners of the Manatee County Mosquito Control District to adopt a resolution and furnish the Manatee County Commissioners with a copy thereof, wherein the Board of County Commissioners in and for Manatee County, Florida is requested to make a levy of taxes for said Manatee County Mosquito Control District upon all taxable real and personal property in said County at the rate of taxation adopted by said Board for said year by said resolution and said amount of taxes to be levied to provide for the fiscal year a sum of not less than \$ 10,000.00 and not more than one-quarter (1/4) mill and **WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Manatee County Mosquito Control District do hereby determine that it will require a millage levy of 0.1280 mill tax to adequately and properly finance the administration of the District for the Fiscal Year of 1984-85, an 8% (eight percent) increase over the roll back rate.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Manatee County Mosquito Control District that the Board of County Commissioners in and for Manatee County, Florida is hereby requested to provide in its budget for the levy and collection of \$ 588,627.00 for said Fiscal Year as provided by the terms of Section 16 and 17 of Chapter 25688, as amended and Chapter 200 F.S. as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be furnished immediately to the Board of County Commissioners in and for Manatee County, Florida for their government in the premises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution become part of the minutes of public hearing held at 5:05 P.M. Monday, September 17, 1984.

Dear Commissioner Chance:

I have been a recipient of therapeutic massage from a state-licensed massage therapist. These treatments have had many positive effects on my health and well-being.

It is most unfortunate for the public and the massage profession that the Manatee County Commission has included this state-licensed health care profession in an "adult entertainment/pornography" ordinance.

Perhaps it hasn't been brought out that the ordinance tends to make the community think that anyone receiving massage is receiving "adult entertainment" or is associated with pornography.

Knowing that individual massage therapists and their establishments are rigidly regulated by Chapter 480, Florida Statutes, I would like you to re-think your position on this ordinance and amend it accordingly.

I am hereby registering my protest with the Commission on this matter.
