The County has been informed that several businesses are operating "adult entertainment" establishments in unincorporated Manatee County in violation of the County Land Development Code. The County Attorney's Office filed suit against one of them, the operator of a lingerie shop allegedly providing adult entertainment in violation of the Manatee County Land Development Code. However, the original business has been sold and a new business is now operating on premises. The purpose of this discussion is to brief the commission on the current litigation status and to receive guidance from the commission on future proceedings.
