- 08/18/98 the Board executed an agreement for a computer aided dispatch and records management system with a telephony switch. This centralized enhanced 911 system service provides the initial location and telephone data to the computer aided dispatch system
- This agreement for centralized enhanced 911 system service is bound by General Service Tariff, Section A24.1 and A24.2 controlled by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- The non-recurring one time system costs include: system hardware circuitry and installation of equipment for automatic location identification; additional E911 exchange lines; and the creation of a master street address guide.
- The recurring cost is an annual estimated amount based on the number of telephone main stations located in the County and rounded to the nearest 1,000 and then multiplied by a tariff rate. The number of telephone main stations for the County as of 06/30/98 is 169, 971.
- The centralized enhanced 911 system services include: alternative routing; automatic call distribution/location identification/number identification; enhanced 911 service area; default routing; and selective routing.
