

COORDINATION AGREEMENT

The Grantee, identified below, agrees to coordinate transportation services to children, young people and the elderly who may have mental or behavioral problems or who are at risk receiving services at facilities operated by Grantee, as required by the Manatee County Community Transportation Coordinator, Manatee County Board of County Commissioners through Manatee County Area Transit, hereinafter referred to as the "Coordinator".

Grantee will identify client transportation needs and refer those who are appropriate to the Coordinator.


Grantee acknowledges that, if feasible, vehicles purchased with Federal funds shall be made available to the Coordinator upon execution of a rate agreement between the Coordinator and the Grantee.

Grantee shall provide ridership and vehicle information, including estimated passenger trips and total funding available for transportation services along with other data reporting requirements as specified in the FY Annual operating report Instructions from the Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged.

BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION:

- The Manatee County Board of County Commissioners is the Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) for Manatee County through Manatee County Area Transit (MCAT)
- The CTC coordinates all para-transit transportation services funded and regulated by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the State Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD).
- Any agency/organization in the coordinated system that requests Section 5310 funding from FDOT to purchase vehicles to provide transportation services must enter into/or renew a coordination agreement with the CTC as part of the application submitted to FDOT by the requesting agency/organization.
- MCAT has a long standing relationship with the following provider and recommends the support of the coordination agreements with Meals on Wheels Plus of Manatee and Easter Seals Southwest Florida.
