BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION (CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1)

- On April 21, 2009, the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners adopted the Manatee County Economic Development Incentive Program which provides for Economic Development Incentive (EDI) Grants.
- EDI Grants are available to qualifying businesses creating new high-wage job opportunities, either by expanding an existing business or by bringing a new business to Manatee County. The incentive is customized per business based on the number of jobs created and percent above 115% of the average Manatee annual wage.
- On November 16, 2010, the BCC adopted Resolution R-10-234 awarding Project Summer (Creonix LLC) an Economic Development Incentive Grant up to \$121,000 to be paid over a four year period.
- Creonix LLC which has been in business since 1988 provides electronic manufacturing services for leading companies in the medical, defense/aerospace, and industrial sectors. Creonix's capabilities include complex box build and systems integration, cable and wire harness manufacturing, and advanced printed circuit board assembly.
- Creonix LLC intends to create 105 new jobs over the next four years, with an average annual wage of \$33,659 which is over 100% of Manatee County's average annual wage for 2009.
- Mr. Ken Piela, CEO representing Creonix LLC, has been invited to make a presentation to the BCC concerning their expanded operations in Manatee County.


