INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
FOR USE OF RECREATIONAL FACILITIES BY AND BETWEEN  
THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA,  
AND  
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA

This Agreement is made and entered into, by and between, the COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and the SCHOOL BOARD OF MANATEE COUNTY, a body corporate, hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOL BOARD."

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to establish and express a reciprocal cooperative relationship between the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD reflecting the intentions of both parties for the mutually beneficial usage of certain recreational facilities belonging to the respective parties; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD have acquired recreational equipment, facilities and land for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD recognize the need for joint usage of their respective recreational equipment, facilities and land to better serve the residents of Manatee County resulting in substantial savings to the public; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Interlocal Agreement, pursuant to the authority of Section 163.01, F.S., (The

DATE October 3, 1965

Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969).

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein, it is agreed between the parties as follows:

1. The COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD agree that it is the policy of each respective entity that their recreational facilities be available for usage by the other party when not in conflict with the use by the party holding title.

2. The COUNTY and SCHOOL BOARD shall instruct their respective administrative staffs to coordinate and develop an appropriate procedure and program to implement this Agreement concerning the sharing of recreational facilities and submit it to each party for review and approval.

3. The COUNTY or SCHOOL BOARD, respectively, shall be responsible for providing the clean-up of any facility used by it following such use of the facility pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement.

4. A party to this Agreement, in making use of a property of the other party, shall be financially responsible for damage to said property as a result of use thereof by the party, normal wear and tear excepted. Notice of any claim under this section shall be made in writing within thirty (30) days of the damage occurring.

5. If a party desires to construct or install capital improvements on the property of the other, such construction, installation and use of the improved facilities shall be the subject of a separate interlocal agreement.

6. Subject to any limitations in Section 768.28, F.S., the COUNTY and School Board agree to save one another harmless from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage resulting from the respective party's use of a facility pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

7. This Agreement shall supersede the Interlocal Agreement between the parties dated May 6, 1980, but shall not supersede any other specific interlocal agreements between the parties regarding particular schools and/or recreational facilities, which agreements shall remain in full force and effect.

8. The delivery of any notices under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been delivered if they are sent by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested and deposited in the U.S. Mail, postage pre-paid and addressed, as the matter may be, to the respective representative of the parties as follows:

9. This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon giving at least (1) year written notice to the other party prior to the effective date of termination.

10. Each of the parties hereto covenants to the other party that it has lawful authority to enter into this Agreement, has authorized execution of this Agreement in open session and has granted signatory authority to the representative signing this Agreement.



## **Grant Opportunity: KaBOOM**

- KaBOOM!, a non-profit dedicated to saving play for children, is offering Joint Use Grants
- Joint Use Grants of \$30,000 are available for the creation of joint use agreements and opening at least eight playgrounds that are not open to the public due to legal or management issues

### **What is Joint Use and Why Use It**

- A joint use agreement is a formal agreement between two separate government entities setting forth the terms and conditions for the shared use of public property
- Usually, each party under a joint use agreement helps fund the development, operation, and maintenance of the facilities that will be shared
- Schools have recreational facilities, but many districts close their property to the public after school hours due to concerns about costs, vandalism, security, maintenance, and liability
- These grant funds will make play more accessible to every child through a joint use policy or Interlocal agreement for some or all of a school district's playgrounds

### **Joint Use Agreements Defined**

- For the purposes of this grant, joint use of school facilities is defined as the following:
- The school gates are unlocked outside of school hours so community members can use the playgrounds for unstructured play
- A local government agency (e.g. Parks and Recreation) or non-profit organization (e.g. Boys and Girls Club) uses playgrounds for public use including after school or weekend physical activity programs

### **Eligibility/Requirements**

- Must have demonstrated experience working with coalitions and community partners
- The target school district has no independent, stand-alone joint use district policy currently in place, but could have joint use practices (as defined above) in place at one or more schools
- Commit to convene a Play Task Force or Committee to support the joint use agreement
- School district administration letter of support and signature on the Letter of Agreement
- Must be willing to develop and pursue adoption of a stand-alone district level joint use policy
- 12 months to implement the joint use agreement, utilize the funds and open the playgrounds for no less than 5 years
- Provide proof of commercial and general liability insurance of at least \$1,000,000
- Communities earning the grants will agree to a match of at least 50% in the form of fundraised support, in-kind services (can include staff time) devoted to this project and other funds
- Submitting a satisfactory mid-year progress report and check-in phone call
- Respond to monthly communications with KaBOOM! and provide updates throughout process
- Demonstrate the joint use agreement is fully implemented once the playgrounds are opened
- Commit to recognizing KaBOOM!, Let's Play and Dr Pepper Snapple Group in media materials

### **Example Allowable Expenses**

- Training and technical assistance (strongly encouraged)
- Minimum fencing and assistance for walking trails located on school grounds
- Utilities and other building operating costs related to the extra use of the facility
- Legal fees
- Contract security services
- Marketing campaign focused on joint use agreement or the community initiative
- Program and activity supplies, approved in writing by KaBOOM!
- Other expenses, approved in writing by KaBOOM!

### **Unallowable Expenses for Grant Funds (Can be included in match component.)**

- Staff salaries, nor overtime funding
- New playground construction
- Administrative costs
- Equipment costs above \$1,000 unless approved by KaBOOM!
- Supplementing public school state requirements
