

RESOLUTION R-13-043

A RESOLUTION BY THE MANATEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO AMEND THE FY 2013 – 2017 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO INCLUDE RECREATIONAL TRAILS FOR ROBINSON PRESERVE PHASE 2.

WHEREAS, Manatee County Adopted Resolution R-12-198 approving a Five Year Capital Improvement Program for FY 2013-2017 and

WHEREAS, Manatee County will be submitting a grant application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection under the Recreational Trails Program for multi use recreational trails at Robinson Preserve Phase 2, and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida encourages applicants to include programs that are being considered for financial assistance be identified in the applicant's most current Capital Improvement or if not identified to amend the Capital Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution B-13-028, on December 18, 2012 amending the FY 2012 -2013 annual budget to include funding for the development of Robinson Preserve Phase 2.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, that:

1. The FY 2013-2017 Capital Improvement Program be amended to include multi use trails for Robinson Preserve, Phase 2 as an established Project of Record.
2. The County will complete the project if funding is awarded under the Recreational Trails Program.

Background Discussion

Manatee County purchased the Robinson Preserve Phase 2 on December 27, 2012.

The Board adopted Resolution R-12-198 on September 13, 2012, which approved the FY 2013-2017 Capital Improvement Program. Since the County did not own the Robinson Preserve Phase 2 property there were no Projects of Record listed in the official document.

The Natural Resources Department will be submitting a grant to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection under the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) for multi use trails in the total amount of \$400,000 (RTP-\$200,000/Manatee County \$200,000). Under the Administrative Rule, applicants can receive 10 points for submitting projects that are included in their adopted CIP. Applicants, if they amend their current CIP to include the project, will receive 5 points.

The Recreational Trails Program is very competitive and staff recommends the Board amend the current CIP to garner as many points as possible.

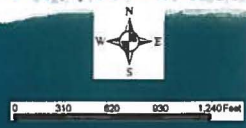

RTP Grant Proposed**

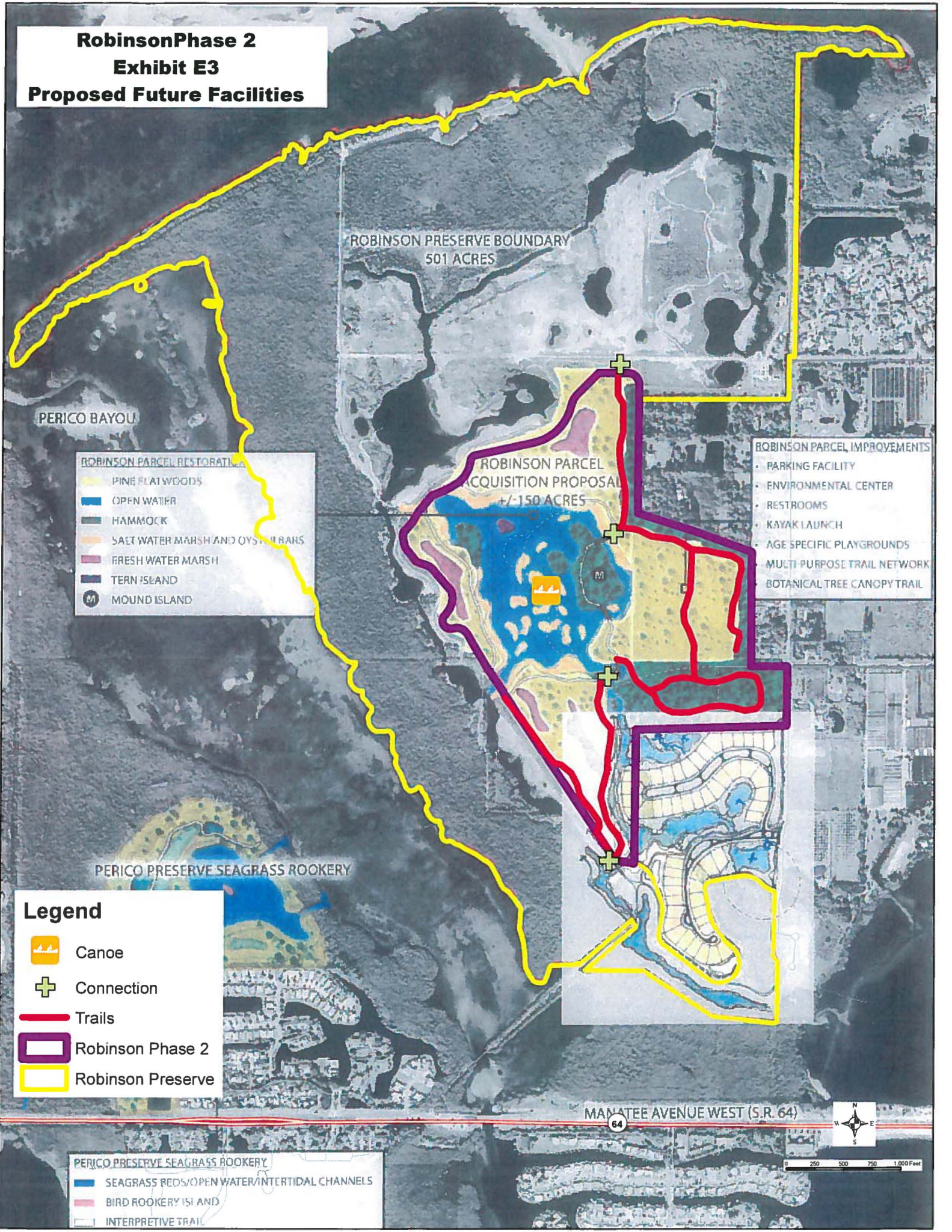

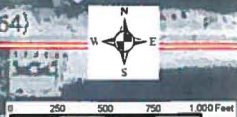
