



Florida Statutes Chapter 427, Rule 41-2, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), required by the Commission and Local Coordinating Board approved Transportation Disadvantaged Service Plan (TDSP).

Background Discussion

The Manatee County Board of County Commissioners is the Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) for Manatee County through Public Works, Manatee County Area Transit Division.

The CTC coordinates all Para-Transit transportation services funded and regulated by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the State Commission of the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD).

Any agency or organization in the coordinated system that requests Section 5310 grant funding from FDOT to purchase vehicles for providing transportation services, must enter into or renew a coordination agreement yearly with the CTC as part of the application submitted to FDOT by the requesting agency or organization.
