## RESOLUTION B-18-067 AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018

- c) Unanticipated revenues, including increased receipts for enterprise or proprietary funds, may be appropriated for their intended purpose, and may be transferred between funds to properly account for the unanticipated revenue.

- Adoption of Budget Resolution B-18-067 amending the annual budget for Manatee County, Florida, for fiscal year 2018.

### Background Discussion

- Amendment #2 decreases the funding by \$26,563, and replaces the Budget Summary to reflect the decrease.
- The decrease in funding is the result of Legislative and Department of Elder Affairs appropriations for the new Specialized Alzheimer's Services program.
- In February 2018 the board authorized a funding increase of \$77,724 to this program. The state should have subtracted the \$26,563 at that time, however, it was an oversight.
- There is no match to these funds
- Budget Resolution B-18-067 reflects the unanticipated decrease in grant revenue.
- The county has served as Lead Agency for the ADI grant program for the past 25 years.
- Grant funds are provided by the State Department of Elder Affairs through the Senior Connection Center, Inc., to provide case management and in-home respite services to residents 18 years of age and older who are living with memory disorders.
