

## MANATEE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. R-18-094

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County, the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management, the National Weather Service have recognized the danger to Manatee County residents, visitors, and business owners from potential tropical and severe weather to Tropical Storm Alberto; and

**WHEREAS**, Manatee County has areas vulnerable to the negative impacts of tropical and severe weather, such as wind, coastal inundation, and freshwater flooding; and

**WHEREAS**, meteorological forecasts cannot predict with absolute certainty the location or severity of tropical or severe weather resulting in hazardous impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, any tropical or severe weather can result in injuries, damage to public and private property, and may result in first responders and government agencies intervening to protect lives, property, and the environment and to reduce impacts to utilities, public buildings, communication systems, transportation systems, and infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 252.38, Florida Statutes provide for the establishment of a local emergency management agency, the appointment of a director thereof, the power and authority thereof, and the power and authority of the Board of County Commissioners in emergency situations; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.46, Florida Statutes, and Manatee County Ordinance 05-29, provide authority for Manatee County to declare a state of local emergency and to exercise the power and authority to carry out the provisions of Florida Statutes Chapter 252, including the authority to waive procedures and formalities otherwise required of political subdivision by law pertaining to:

- 1) Performance of public work and taking whatever prudent actions necessary to ensure the health; safety; and welfare of the community;

- 2) Entering into contracts;
- 3) Incurring obligations;
- 4) Employment of permanent and temporary workers;
- 5) Utilization of volunteer workers;
- 6) Rental of equipment;
- 7) Acquisition and distribution, with or without compensation, of supplies, materials, and facilities; and,
- 8) Appropriation and expenditure of public funds.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018, that the potential for tropical and severe weather poses a threat to the lives and property of residents of Manatee County and that a State of Local Emergency is hereby declared, effective immediately for all territory within the legal boundaries of Manatee County, including all unincorporated and incorporated areas.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners hereby waives the above-mentioned procedures and formalities required by law of a political subdivision, as provided in Section 252.38(3), Florida Statutes and Manatee County Ordinance 05-29.

**BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners hereby delegates to the Director of Public Safety the authority to discharge the duties and exercise the powers specified in Section 9A of Manatee County Ordinance 05-29, until such time as the Local Emergency declared herein is terminated or expired or seven days from this date, whichever is sooner.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commission hereby delegates to the Director of Public Safety the authority to implement disaster emergency plans, agreements, and supporting documents in accordance with Section 5A of Manatee County Ordinance 05-29.

## **Commissioners to consider local state of emergency during 3 p.m. meeting**

*Subtropical Storm Alberto may bring heavy rains, potential flooding in low-lying areas around Manatee County*

MANATEE COUNTY, FL (May 25, 2018) – County Commissioners are expected to declare a local state of emergency today at a 3 p.m. meeting to discuss the latest on Subtropical Storm Alberto.

During the meeting, Public Safety Director Bob Smith will ask Commissioners to declare a local state of emergency in an abundance of caution before heavy rains this weekend. The declaration is the first step local officials must take to allow County staff to be prepared to make special purchases relating to storm preparation and response if necessary over the holiday weekend.

The meeting will take place in the first floor County Commission Chambers of Manatee County Administrative Building, 1112 Manatee Ave. W.

There are no plans yet for an evacuation or shelter openings, but County residents should monitor the news and the County's social media pages for updates.

Manatee County Public Works will distribute sandbags today until 7 p.m. and

tomorrow, May 26 from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. at Manatee County Transit & Fleet Facility, 2411 Tallevast Road.

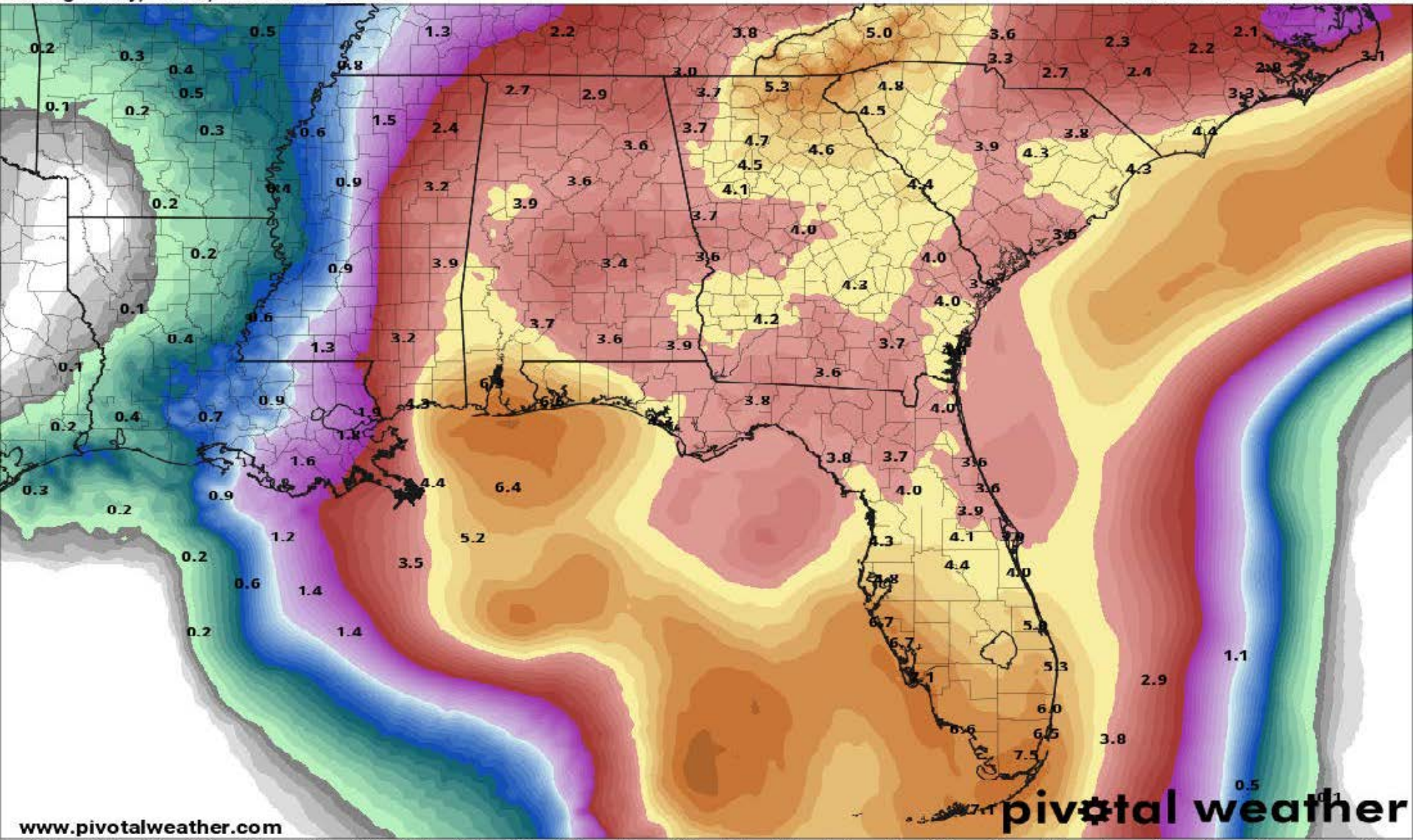

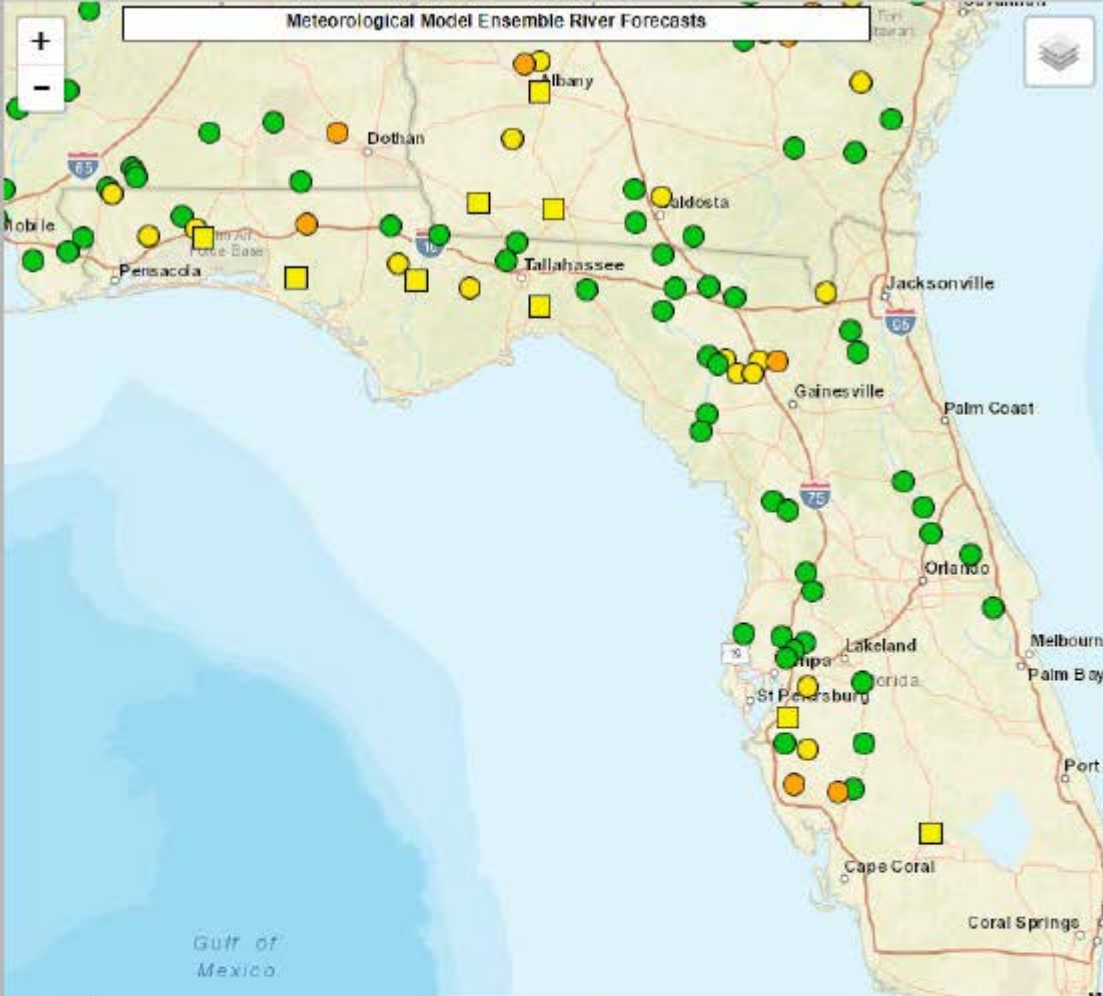

# 7 Day Chance of River Flooding



In addition to the flash flooding potential, minor to moderate flooding on area rivers will be possible, but this will ultimately be dependent on where the heaviest rain falls. The areas for concern are currently in West Central Florida, the Florida Panhandle, and the Santa Fe River basin and Paynes Prairie State Park.

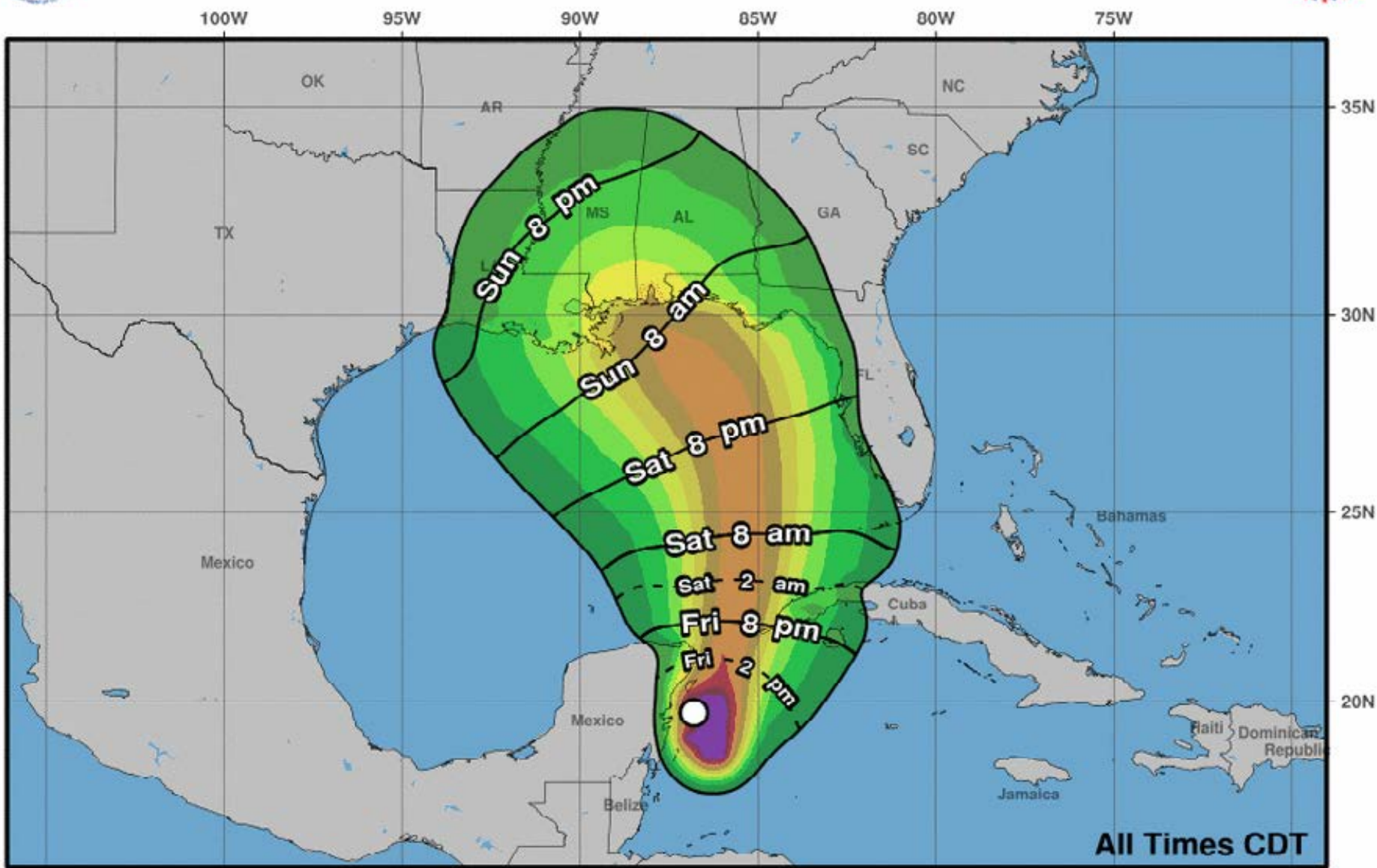
