

THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between Senior Connection Center, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "agency" and Manatee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "subrecipient", amends Contract No. HCE-17/18-MAN.

The purpose of this amendment is to:

- 1) increase Section 3, Contract Amount, by \$1,200.00;
- 2) increase Section 5, Source of Funds, by \$1,200.00; and
- 3) revise and replace ATTACHMENT III, Budget Summary.

1. Section 3, is hereby amended to read:

**3. Contract Amount**

The agency agrees to pay for services according to the conditions of ATTACHMENT I in an amount not to exceed \$59,788.00, subject to the availability of funds.

2. Section 5, is hereby amended to read:

**5. Source of Funds**

The costs of services paid under any other contract or from any other source are not eligible for reimbursement under this contract. The funds awarded to the subrecipient pursuant to this contract are in the state grants and aids appropriations and consist of the following:

All provisions not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the contract.

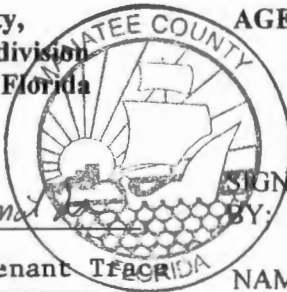

- Authorization for the Chairman to execute Amendment #2 of the HCE-17/18-MAN agreement with the Senior Connection Center, Inc., for the Home Care for the Elderly Program increasing the Subsidy category by \$1,200 and adopting a new Budget Summary reflecting this change.

Enabling/Regulating Authority

Florida Statutes Chapter 125

Background Discussion

- Based on the surplus within the planning and service area, amendment #2 allows for the increase of \$1,200 into the Subsidy category.
- These additional funds will allow for clients to be reimbursed for the out of pocket costs of such things as incontinent supplies.
- Home Care for the Elderly grant funds are provided by the state through the Senior Connection Center, Inc., to provide Case Management, Basic, and Special Subsidy services to persons sixty years of age or older to prevent or delay premature institutional placement.
- The HCE program encourages the provision of care for the elderly in family type living arrangements in private homes as an alternative to nursing home or other institutional care settings.
- No budget amendment is required for subsidies as this year the state combined the HCE services (case management and subsidy) under one spending authority.
