

THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between Senior Connection Center, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "agency" and Manatee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "subrecipient", amends Contract No. CCE-20/21-MAN.

The purpose of this amendment is to:

- 1) increase Section 3, Contract Amount, by **\$82,596.00**;
- 2) amend Section 4, Obligation to Pay, renamed Payment;
- 3) increase Section 5, Source of Funds, by **\$82,596.00**;
- 4) amend Section 10, renamed Termination, Suspension, Enforcement, and Survival;
- 5) amend Attachment I, Section 35(4), Consequences for Non-Compliance; and
- 6) revise and replace ATTACHMENT III, Budget Summary.

1. Section 3, is hereby amended to read:

3. Contract Amount

The agency agrees to pay for services according to the conditions of ATTACHMENT I in an amount not to exceed **\$1,273,264.00**, subject to the availability of funds.

2. Section 4, is hereby amended to read:

4. Payment

The agency’s performance and obligation to pay under this contract is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature passed through the Department of Elder Affairs to the agency, and the subrecipient strictly performing the terms and conditions of this contract. Nothing in this contract supersedes the contingency to payment described in Paragraph 49 of the Master Contract. Payment under this contract shall at all times be subject to Paragraph 49 of the Master Contract.

3. Section 5, is hereby amended to read:

5. Source of Funds

The costs of services paid under any other contract or from any other source are not eligible for reimbursement under this contract. The funds awarded to the subrecipient pursuant to this contract are in the state grants and aids appropriations and consist of the following:

4. Section 10, is hereby amended to read:

10. Termination, Suspension, Enforcement, and Survival

The causes and remedies for suspension or termination of this contract shall follow the same procedures as outlined in the Master Contract. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to limit Section 55 of the Master Contract regarding survival of various obligations.

5. ATTACHMENT I, Section 35(4), is hereby amended to read:

(4) If the subrecipient fails to submit a timely CAP, the agency shall deduct two percent (2%) of the monthly value of the contract for each business day the CAP is overdue, beginning with the 11th day after notification of the deficiency by the agency. The deduction will be made from the payment for the invoice of the following month. The agency's authority in this Section 35 is in addition to any other agency remedies in this contract or the Master Contract. All Financial Consequences in this section shall not be considered a penalty, but a withholding of funds to assist agency in ensuring all funds are expended as required and available for funding to meet program services.

6. ATTACHMENT III, Budget Summary, is hereby replaced with the revised ATTACHMENT III, Budget Summary, attached hereto.

This amendment shall be effective on the last date that the amendment is signed by both parties.

All provisions in the contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the contract.

This amendment and all its attachments are hereby made a part of the contract.

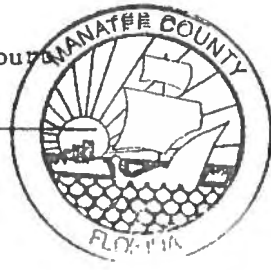

RESOLUTION B-21-026
AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET
FOR MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 129.06, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to amend its budget for the current fiscal year as follows:

- a) Appropriations for expenditures in any fund may be decreased and other appropriations in the same fund correspondingly increased, provided the total appropriations of the fund are not changed.
- b) Appropriations from reserves may be made to increase the appropriation for any particular expense in the same fund, or to create an appropriation in the fund for any lawful purpose.
- c) Unanticipated revenues, including increased receipts for enterprise or proprietary funds, may be appropriated for their intended purpose, and may be transferred between funds to properly account for the unanticipated revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that the 2020-2021 budget is hereby amended in accordance with FS 129.06 as described in the description and specified in the budget adjustment batch file listed below:

Fund: GENERAL FUND
Description: Appropriates \$82,596 of grant revenue in the Grants fund to increase funding received from the Senior Connection Center for the 2020-2021 Community Care for the Elderly (CCE) grant per Amendment #001 (Contract No. CCE 20/21 MAN). Also, deappropriates \$1,052 of co-payment revenues to align budgeted revenues and expenditures with actuals. This budget amendment is being presented to the Board of County Commissioners along with the grant agreement.

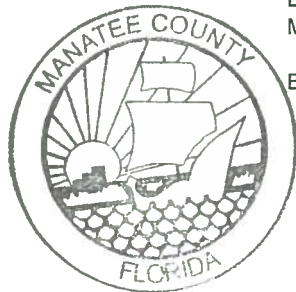

Background Discussion

On June 16, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved the State FY 20/21 funding agreement for the Community Care for the Elderly (CCE) grant funded program. Amendment 001 allows for an overall increase of \$82,596.

The additional funds are a result of Legislative appropriations received from the Department of Elder Affairs and have been allocated according to the state approved funding formula. There

is a 10% required match to this program that had already been approved with the original agreement.

CCE grant funds are provided by the state to provide Cases Management, Emergency Alert Response, Homemaker, Medical Transportation, Personal Care, Home Delivered Meals, Respite, and Adult Daycare to persons 60 years of age or older to prevent or delay premature institutional placement. Case Management and Medical Transportation are provided by the County directly through Neighborhood Services and Manatee County Area Transit respectively. All other services are provided through subcontract.

The additional funds will allow for Manatee County to enroll new clients into the program from the wait list.
