Authorization to rescind the aggregate not-to-exceed amount for Agreement No. 18-TA002693AJ for Corrosion and Odor Control Services with Premier Magnesia, LLC and Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC.

Background Discussion

On May 22, 2018, the County entered into Agreement No. 18-TA002693AJ for Corrosion and Odor Control Services with Premier Magnesia, LLC and Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC. The initial agreement term was for one (1) year beginning May 22, 2018 and ending May 21, 2019 with four (4) additional one (1) year renewal options. The Agreements provide services to minimize corrosion effects on wastewater infrastructure and address nuisance odor issues in the wastewater collection and treatment systems.

Agreement No. 18-TA002693AJ is structured as a Blanket Term Agreement by which Release Orders are issued to Premier Magnesia, LLC and Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC on an as-needed basis. The Release Orders are based on the amount of services provided as outlined in

Agreement No. 18-TA002693AJ. The Release Order is directly associated with the requesting Department's Board of County Commissioners (BCC)-approved budget and specified account codes are used when encumbering funds through the Release Order.

On April 23, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved Amendment No. 1 which extended the Agreements for one (1) year beginning May 22, 2019 and ending May 21, 2020 for a not-to-exceed annual amount of \$985,740.00 with Premier Magnesia, LLC and a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,500,000.00 with Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC.

On July 25, 2019, the County executed Amendment No. 2 which amended specific fee rates pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

On May 21, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved Amendment No. 3 which extended the Agreements for one (1) additional year beginning May 22, 2020 and ending May 21, 2021. Amendment No. 3 removed the individual agreement annual not-to-exceed amounts for each Agreement and replaced it with a combined annual not-to-exceed amount of \$4,500,000.00 for Corrosion and Odor Control Services.

On May 20, 2021, the County executed Amendment No. 4 which extended the Agreements beginning May 22, 2021 and ending May 21, 2022 and revised Exhibit B - Fee Rate Schedule for both Agreements in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

Based on the projected increase in services required, the Utilities Department estimates the annual expenditure will be approximately \$5,500,000.00. The Utilities Department is requesting the aggregate Agreement total not-to-exceed amount be removed and funding be directly associated to the Board of County Commissioner (BCC)-approved departmental budget. By removing the aggregate Agreement not-to-exceed amount, the Utilities Department will be able to accommodate the increased level of service at the 645 locations throughout Manatee County. Any deviation in funding will require a Budget Amendment be brought before the Board of County Commissioners for approval prior to processing the requested Release Order.
