

RESOLUTION NO. R-26-015

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING RENAMING A PUBLIC
STREET; RENAMING POST BOULEVARD TO PREMIER SPORTS
BOULEVARD; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Manatee County owns and operates the facility known as the Premier Sports Campus for the purpose of providing a recreation sports venue and promoting tourism in Manatee County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Post Boulevard is a public roadway located in Manatee County, Florida, bordered by Rangeland Parkway to the north and State Road 70 to the south, lying outside of the boundaries of any incorporated municipality, serving residents, businesses, and visitors within the Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners (Board) to name and rename county roadways lying outside the boundaries of any incorporated municipality; and

WHEREAS, the proposed name, Premier Sports Boulevard, reflects Manatee County's long-term investment in athletic facilities, recreation, travel leagues, and regional sports tourism that generate economic impact and strengthen community engagement; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County hosts numerous local and regional sporting events, tournaments, and athletic programs that attract visitors and contribute to increased revenue for surrounding businesses, lodging, and community facilities; and

WHEREAS, renaming the roadway to Premier Sports Boulevard will enhance wayfinding and better align the roadway's identity with Manatee County's reputation as a destination for premier sports and recreational programming; and

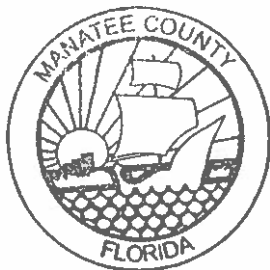
WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Manatee County to rename Post Boulevard to Premier Sports Boulevard for the purposes of community identity, regional recognition, and economic development.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interests of Manatee County to adopt this Resolution and rename this public street from Post Boulevard to Premier Sports Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, as follows.

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby adopted as findings of this Board and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The public roadway herein described and currently known as Post Boulevard is hereby renamed Premier Sports Boulevard.
3. The County Administrator or his/her designee is hereby authorized and directed to replace all existing signage consistent with this Resolution.
4. The County Administrator is hereby directed to take all appropriate steps necessary to cause all relevant Manatee County maps to be amended to reflect the new name for this roadway as soon as reasonably practical and consistent with all applicable laws, ordinances and resolutions governing same.
5. The County Administrator is hereby directed to cause copies of this Resolution to be transmitted to all appropriate authorities, including, but not limited to, applicable fire districts, law enforcement, stewardship districts, and the United States Postal Service.
6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

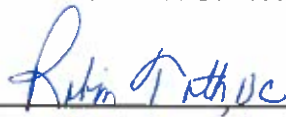

Background Discussion

Premier Sports Campus, owned by Manatee County, is undergoing significant investment, and renaming Post Boulevard to Premier Sports Boulevard will support clearer wayfinding, promotion, and facility identification. The U.S. Postal Service has been notified and does not anticipate any major impacts. The Stewardship District has expressed support for the change. At the January 6, 2026, Board of County Commissioners meeting, Deputy County Administrator Parnell presented this consideration, and no objections were raised by the Board.

Good Evening Molly:

In this Request for Legal Services (RLS), you have asked the County Attorney's Office (CAO) to review (1) a draft resolution renaming a public street (Resolution), (2) a notice of public hearing in furtherance of same (Notice), and (3) a fiscal impact statement (Statement).

The following facts and information are relevant to my response:

1. You report that:
 - Premier Sports Campus is seeing significant investments;
 - Renaming Post Boulevard to Premier Campus Boulevard will aid in way-finding, promotion, and identification;
 - The post office has been notified and does not anticipate significant impacts;
 - The stewardship is in favor of this change;
 - The addressing department is aware; and
 - At the January 6, 2026, Board meeting, County Administration addressed the Board regarding this and no objection was made.
2. Included with the RLS was also a copy of Resolution R-20-153, which pertains to naming of parks, buildings, monuments, statues, highway, streets, and other public facilities in honor of individuals or organizations.
3. My understanding is that Post Boulevard is a section of roadway a little more than half a mile in length which runs south of Rangeland Parkway ending at State Road 70.

I offer the following legal advice in response to this RLS:

1. Attached is a redlined copy of the Resolution which contains my suggested changes, comments, and advice.
2. Pursuant to Section 336.02, Florida Statutes, the Board has overall authority and management responsibility for county roads within its jurisdictional boundaries. Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board to name and rename streets and roads within the County (except state roads designated by number) lying

- outside the boundaries of any incorporated municipality.
3. Resolution R-20-153 is not applicable in this context because the renaming of this road does not involve honoring an individual or organization.
 4. Because the renaming of this road is not honorary in nature, no public hearing is required, no fiscal impact statement is required, and there is no requirement to publish notice. For that reason, I have not performed any review of the Notice or Statement.
 5. Except as otherwise indicated, I have not reviewed or revised the Resolution for thoroughness, accuracy, typographical errors, or ADA accessibility. Provided the legal concerns and issues identified herein and attached are addressed consistently with my advice, I have no objection from a legal standpoint to this matter being presented to the Board for review and consideration.
