- a) Appropriations for expenditures in any fund may be decreased and other appropriations in the same fund correspondingly increased, provided the total appropriations of the fund are not changed.
- b) Appropriations from reserves may be made to increase the appropriation for any particular expense in the same fund, or to create an appropriation in the fund for any lawful purpose.
- c) Unanticipated revenues, including increased receipts for enterprise or proprietary funds, may be appropriated for their intended purpose, and may be transferred between funds to properly account for the unanticipated revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that the 2025-2026 budget is hereby amended in accordance with FS 129.06 as described in the description and specified in the budget adjustment batch file listed below:

### **Background Discussion**

On June 17, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners approved the State FY 25/26 funding agreement for the Alzheimer's Disease Initiative (ADI) grant funded program.

On November 4, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners approved Amendment 001 increasing funding by \$20,996.00 as a result of Legislative appropriations received from the Department of Elder Affairs. The Amendment 002 increase is due to another county in the Service Provider area which consists of Manatee, Hillsborough, Polk, Hardee and Highlands counties was running a surplus and unable to spend the funds. Manatee County can utilize these funds to ensure clients will not experience a reduction in their in home services through the end of the contract which is June 30, 2026 due to running a deficit.

ADI funds are used to provide services including but not limited to Case Management, In-Home Respite, Homemaker and Personal Care to assist caregivers caring for someone with a memory impairment.
