PUBLIC HEARING APPLICATIONS (INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION)

- 1. VA-03-15- SARABAY COUNTRY CLUB DRIVING RANGE** (Laurie Suess, Planning Manager)
Approval of a variance to allow 50 ft. tall poles that hold the nets around the driving range within the front yard setback. This is a variance of both height and setbacks. The poles will exceed the 35 ft. maximum height and will encroach 25 ft. into the required 25 ft. front yard setback. The Sarabay Country Club is at 7011 Willow Street, Whitfield and present zoning is RSF-3. The proposed poles and netting are along the south side of Magellan Drive abutting the driving range (± 110 acres).
- 2. SP-04-03- JOSEPH HARRIS, D/B/A PAPA JOE'S BAR** (Erika Barrett, Planner)
Approval of a Special Permit to allow a drinking establishment (4-COP Beer, Wine and Liquor) in the NC-S zoning district at 1240-1242 Whitfield Avenue (+2.37 acres).

PUBLIC NOTICE

Copies of these sections of the Code are available for review, or purchase at cost, at the Planning Department, 4th Floor, Manatee County Administrative Center, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida.

According to Florida Statutes, Section 286.0105, any person desiring to appeal any decision made by a Hearing Officer with respect to any matter considered at this Public Hearing will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
