Minutes of the Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of Manatee, State of Florida at a regular meeting of said Board held at the Court House in the City of Bradenton said County and State on the first Monday in December 1929, the same being the 2nd day of December 1929.

Present and presiding the Hon, J. P. Harlee, Chairman of said Board, also present W. I. Kirkhuff, D. W. Dansby, J. H. Young and C. F. Armstrong, members of said Board, Robb. H. Rosch, Clerk and J. P. Davidson, Sheriff of Manatee County, Florida.

Meeting was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

T. C. Easterling Traffic Officer of Manatee County then appeared before the Board and requested that the Board buy him a new uniform and upon motion of Mr. Dansby duly seconded and carried by vote of the Board said traffic officer was directed to procure a new uniform and that the Board of County Commissioners would pay for same.

Mr A. P. Turner then presented bills for the Burial of Freeman, Foley and Mizell and Mr Armstrong having investigated said bills on motion of Mr. Armstrong duly seconded and carried by vote of the said Board the said bills were ordered paid same amounting to \$135.00

On motion of Mr. Dansby duly seconded and carried by vote of the Board Johnnie Robinson (colored) was allowed the sum of \$5.00 per month until further orders of the Board.

Mrs. W. H. Maples having applied for a mothers pension and said application having been investigated by the proper authority on motion of Mr Dansby duly seconded and carried by vote of the Board she was allowed a mothers pension in the sum of \$10.00 per month

Whereas, petition has been filed by Bentley-Trezevant, Inc., a Florida Corporation showing that it is the owner and holder of the legal title to the following described property in Manatee County, Florida, to wit:

Government Lot Three (3) of Section 35, including all riparian rights, and the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 36, Township 35 South, Range 17 East Manatee County, Florida, less a strip of land 330 feet wide across the South end of said property, and subject to the right of way of the Tamiami-Trail through the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said property,

And further showing that said property was subdivided and that streets, highways, drive ways and alley ways were attempted to be dedicated in and by the plat of said above described property which was and is known as "SEAGATE";

And further showing that the offer of dedication made in said plat has never been accepted by the public, by any user, by public authority, or by expressed enactment, said said petition withdraws the offer of dedication made in and by said plat, and

Whereas, said petition prays for an order from this body vacating and discontinuing and all roads, highways, streets and public ways laid out, dedicated or shown, or attempted to be laid out, dedicated or shown in and by said plat of Seagate, or on the property covered by said plat of SEAGATE which is hereinabove described, and that all rights of the public in and to said roads, highways, streets and public ways are vacated;

Now therefore, be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Manatee County, Florida, that any and all roads, highways, streets or public ways dedicated, shown, set out and / or established, or attempted to be dedicated, shown, set out and/or established, by said plat of Seagate, on or across the property hereinabove described, be and the same are hereby vacated discontinued and set aside and that any and all public rights which might

exist in same and hereby declared null and of no effect.
