

February 18, 1941

Minutes of an adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, held at the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, on Tuesday, February, 18, 1941, at 2:00 P.M.

Commissioners Knight, Harilee, Gillett, Roadman and McLeod, with Deputy Clerk, W. H. Fletcher, and Attorney G. B. Knowles present.

The meeting was opened by proclamation by the Sheriff.

Motion was made by Mr. Harilee that \$1,104.38 be deposited in the Manatee River Bank and Trust Company for Manatee County payment of one-fourth of purchase price of property, said property being for the use of enlargement of the Manatee-Sarasota Airport, the owners of said property being: Elizabeth Zwinggi, Mr. & Mrs. Hans Souder, Mr. & Mrs. A. F. Wightman, and the Davis Estates, also Lots 9 to 18, inclusive, Block 13, Ballentine Manor, Bay Heights Section, also, approximately 20 acres of Kuser Estates. The deal for this property to be closed after title to said property has been approved by G. B. Knowles, Attorney for the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County. The motion was seconded by Mr. McLeod and carried by the unanimous vote of the Board.

At the request of Attorney G.B. Knowles the following resolution closing certain streets in The Palms Subdivision was unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Manatee, State of Florida, that all indicated roads, streets and alleys, all dedicated spaces and all spaces indicated as being the subject matter of an offer of dedication, lying within the north half of The Palms Addition to the City of Bradenton, Florida, except such portion thereof as is now a part of the extension and the widening of the Tamiami Trail, be and the same are hereby abrogated and closed and the offer of dedication contained in that certain recorded plat in Plat Book No. 4, page 11, of the public records of Manatee County, Florida, is hereby declined and refused on behalf of the public of Manatee County, Florida, it being the intent and purpose hereof to abrogate and close the whole of Plumosa Avenue running east and west through said north half of said subdivision, and all that part of Palm Avenue lying north of the center line of Block B, extended to the center line of Block E of said subdivision plat: provided, however, that this resolution and the action of this Board does not purport to close or to affect the other roads, highways, streets and alleys shown in and on said recorded plat except as hereinabove expressly described.

The foregoing resolution was moved by Mr. Harilee, seconded by Mr. Gillett.

On motion by Mr. Harilee, seconded by Mr. Roadman, the following resolution transferring \$1,608.76 from the Publicity Fund to the Federal Matching Fund was adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Manatee, State of Florida, subject always to the consent and approval of the Comptroller of the State of Florida, that there should be transferred and it is hereby so ordered, the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Eight and 76/100 Dollars (\$1,608.76) now in the Treasury of said county to the credit of the Publicity Fund to the Federal Matching Fund of said County, such transfers to be effective as soon as this resolution shall receive the approval of the Comptroller of the State of Florida.

Motion was made by Mr. Harilee that Commissioner Knight and Engineer Horton be requested to confer with other Sponsors of the Manatee-Sarasota Joint Airport Project in regard to the purchase of an additional 140 acres of land lying north of the present airport site. Motion was seconded by Mr. McLeod, and carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Harilee that this Board deposit \$250.00 in the Revolving Fund in the Manatee River Bank and Trust Company for the purchase of sponsors' gas through the aid of Federal Procurement Division, U.S. Treasury Depart, it being understood that the three remaining sponsors would deposit like amount in this fund for the same purpose. Motion was seconded by Mr. Gillett, and carried.
