has filed a petition praying that the Board of County Commissioners pass such resolutions and take such steps and actions pursuant to Chapter 24205, Laws of Florida, 1947, as are necessary for the closing, abandoning and vacating of, for the refusing of the offer of dedication of, and for the renouncing and disclaiming of any right of the county and of the public in and to that certain street, road, boulevard or highway and piece or parcel of land dedicated as a street, road, boulevard or highway described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Manatee, State of Florida, that said Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on the 5th day of June, A. D. 1950, at the offices of said Board in the County Court House in Bradenton, Florida, at which time said Board of County Commissioners will consider and determine the advisability of the closing, abandoning and vacating of, and the refusing of the offer of dedication of, and the renouncing and disclaiming of any right of the county and of the public in and to that certain street, road, boulevard or highway and piece or parcel of land dedicated as a street, road, boulevard or highway situate in the County of Manatee and State of Florida described above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Board of County Commissioners shall publish notice of such hearing one time in a newspaper of general circulation in said county at least two weeks prior to the date of such hearing, to-wit, June 5, 1950.

Upon motion by Mr. Burnett, seconded by Mr. Haynes, the Board adjourned until Monday, May 22nd, 1950 at 9:00 a.m.
