

May 31, 1960

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in the court House in Bradenton, Florida, Tuesday, May 31st, 1960., this being considered the regular meeting of the Board, Monday, May 30th, being a legal holiday.

Present were Commissioners John G. Jones, H. C. Slaughter, Irwin Klemmer, Elmer Bustle and Tom W. Jennings, Deputy Clerk Bruce M. Cox and County Attorney George H. Harrison.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Slaughter.

Minutes of the meeting of May 16th, 1960 were read. The Chairman stated that if there were no alterations, corrections or additions the Minutes would stand approved as read.

DOWNTOWN BRADENTON ASSOCIATION
RECOMMENDATION TO BOARD TO MOVE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND JAIL TO ANOTHER LOCATION

Fred McKenna, spokesman for a committee of members of the Downtown Bradenton Association, read a letter to the Board suggesting that the County jail and the Sheriff's office be removed from the Court House to some suitable location, which would relieve the parking problem at the court house and provide additional space for other departments.

After discussion and observations from the Board members on the subject, Chairman Slaughter advised that budgetary funds had been provided for a building at the Engineering Department site to house the Planning and Zoning and Building Departments and that the plans were completed and ready for final approval; that when these Departments were moved some 1300 square feet would be available for other offices, in the court house. Plans and specifications for the Court House Addition, already approved by the Board, were also discussed, and the committee was advised that various means of financing such addition were now under study.

In recognizing the merits of the plan presented the Board thanked the Association members for their interest, assuring them that the recommendation would be given consideration.

GREGORY ESTATES ACCESS ROAD
RIGHTS-OF-WAY DEEDS ACCEPTED

John Benson, Jr., County Engineer, presented right of way agreements for extension of 17th Street into 38th Avenue, which would give through outlet into Cortez Road from GREGORY ESTATES. He explained that of the three possibilities for access roads investigated this route was the easiest and least expensive, however, it would be necessary sometime in the future to provide still another through street in the area.
