

December 27, 1960

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in REGULAR SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Tuesday, December 27th, 1960 at 9:30 a.m. (Christmas Day was Sunday and the following Monday observed as legal holiday)

Present were Commissioners John G. Jones, H. C. Slaughter, Irwin Klemmer, Elmer Bustle and Tom W. Jennings, Deputy Clerk Bruce M. Cox and County Attorney George H. Harrison.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Slaughter.

MIDWAY ESTATES
ACTION RE VACATION OF PLAT RESCINDED

R E S O L U T I O N

William Harrison, attorney for the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority, joined by Matt V. Pilcher, Secretary to the Authority, came before the Board to protest the closing of certain streets and roads in MIDWAY ESTATES, a subdivision lying north of the Sarasota-Bradenton Airport, because there was misrepresentation of facts in the petition.

"All of MIDWAY ESTATES SUBDIVISION, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 8, page 28 of the Public Records of Manatee County, Florida LESS AND EXCEPT that portion of Hardin Avenue lying within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 35 South, Range 17 East, and LESS AND EXCEPT that portion of U. S. Highway 301, if any, lying within the platted portion of said subdivision, and LESS AND EXCEPT that portion of that certain drainage canal, if any, lying within or abutting the Southerly line of said subdivision, and LESS AND EXCEPT Lots 1 and 2, Block 1 of said subdivision.

PETITIONERS: CATHOLIC BURSE ENDOWMENT FUND, INC.

Mr. Harrison advised that the petitioners alleged that the closing of the streets in the subdivision, other than the one excepted (Hardin Avenue), would not affect any right of access, however, the closing of the road immediately north of the airport deprived said airport of means of ingress and egress to the northern portion of the field.

Motion was made by Mr. Bustle that the Board adopt a resolution rescinding its action in vacating the Plat of Midway Estates Subdivision. Motion was seconded by Mr. Klemmer and carried unanimously. RECORDED A16-111

RENTAL UNITS: RIGHT OF WAY STATE ROAD 55 (U.S. 19 & 41) COMMITTEE APPOINTED TO RECOMMEND RATES, COLLECTOR, ETC.

Don McGuire, right-of-way agent, submitted a list of buildings (25) located in the right of way of State Road 55, north of Manatee River, now available for rent by the county in accordance with State Road Department procedure.

Inasmuch as it will be necessary to appoint someone to collect the rent from the units, after the rates are set and the necessary arrangements made, it was suggested that G. H. Robinson (presently working as right-of-way agent) be designated as collector, to be compensated on a percentage basis.

The Chairman appointed Commissioners Klemmer and Bustle as a committee to confer with Don McGuire as to amount of rent to be charged on the units, and to work out some satisfactory arrangements with Mr. Robinson on collections, and submit recommendations to the Board next week.

Upon motion by Mr. Jennings, seconded by Mr. Jones, the County Engineer was authorized to repave the stub taxi strips at the Airport in accordance with request, and bill the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority for the work.

**COUNTY DEPARTMENTS' BOOTHS AT FAIR
COMMITTEE TO WORK OUT DETAILS**

Mr. Bustle relayed suggestion of the County Fair officials that the Board consider having the County Departments have booths at the County Fair for the purpose of offering information to the public on county activities and achievements. A committee of Commissioners Bustle, Klemmer and Slaughter agreed to investigate this matter and work out details for booths.

STATHIS, ANTHONY L. APPOINTED COUNTY PHYSICIAN

Motion was made by Mr. Jennings that ANTHONY L. STATHIS, M. D., be appointed County Physician to replace Dr. H. R. Taxdal, resigned. Motion was seconded by Mr. Jones.

Chairman Slaughter explained that the possibility of Dr. Frederick Allen, Health Director, acting in administrative capacity, with indigents to go to the physician of their choice and bills to be rendered for medical service, was not deemed feasible and in the best interest of Public Health.

Motion carried unanimously.

**SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS AUTHORIZED TRANSFERRED
DISTRICT NO. 5**

**FROM UPPER MANATEE RIVER ROAD
TO FLAT FORD BRIDGE**

Mr. Jennings explained that anticipated materials salvaged from the Sneads Island Bridge to be used in rebuilding the Flat Ford Bridge in District No. 5 were not forthcoming and the budgeted amount for this project was not sufficient to construct a concrete bridge, which was considered more feasible and economical than wooden replacement, and requested authorization to transfer \$10,000.00 from the Upper Manatee River Road Project to the Flat Ford Bridge Project. (Road to be repaved but narrow bridges to be replaced in/ another budget year)

Upon motion by Mr. Bustle, seconded by Mr. Jones, transfer of funds from the Upper Manatee River Road Project to the Flat Ford Bridge Project was authorized.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to meet Tuesday, January 3rd, 1961 at 9:30 a.m.
