The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the court house in Bradenton, Florida, Monday, July 17th, 1961 at 12:05 p.m.

MANATEE VETERANS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL
FINAL PLANS APPROVED ✓

Mr. Jack Wohlberg, of Pullara and Watson, Architects and Engineers, presented final plans for the addition to the Manatee Veterans Memorial Hospital and requested approval to forward them to the Hospital Division of the Florida Development Commission and to the United States Public Health Department in Atlanta. The plan was presented for eighty-one beds, with alternate proposal providing for an additional thirty-four beds. Mr. Wohlberg stated that alternate drawings would be ready in approximately four weeks and advertised to receive bids before September 15th, 1961 and it was estimated that completion date would be fifteen to eighteen months from the starting date. The painting contract, estimated at approximately \$5,000.00, is to include both the old and new parts of the building.

Mr. Victor Sledge, administrator, stated that the Board of Trustees of the Hospital had approved the plans and the monies involved.

Mr. Bibey made a motion to approve the plans and allocate funds as submitted consistent with the approval of the Trustees. Motion was seconded by Mr. Slaughter and carried.
