

SEPTEMBER 19, 1961

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Tuesday, September 19, 1961 at 10:10 A. M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crist, who explained that the purpose of the meeting was to take action relative to advertisement for bids for additions and alterations to the Manatee Veterans Memorial Hospital.

Chairman Crist read a letter from Watson and Company, architects, and copy of Invitation to Bid on additions to the Hospital as suggested context for advertisement. The architects suggested that Bids on additions be opened October 30th and bids on Kitchen Equipment and Sterilizers be opened November 13th.

Motion was made by Mr. Bibey that Invitation for Bids be advertised for additions and alterations to the Manatee Veterans Memorial Hospital, to be opened October 30th, 1961; form of Invitation to be as submitted, with exception of substitution of the word "County" instead of "Owner" if the Chairman deems it advisable after conferring with the architects. Motion was seconded by Mr. Klemmer and carried.
