RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that the retail sales of all alcoholic beverages shall be prohibited in said county during the hours the polling places are open for the purpose of holding an Election on Tuesday, November 7, 1961, said hours being from 7:00 A. M. to 7:00 P. M.
