The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Wednesday, November 20th, 1963 at 1:30 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bibey, who opened PUBLIC HEARING for the purpose of considering Amendments and Changes to the Southern Standard Building Code, Part III, Plumbing, 1962-1963 Edition.

During the Public Hearing, addition of a new item (1211) concerning installation of wells was discussed at length (considered necessary because of recent water shortage problem in the Palma Soal area). Some modification to amendment regarding Certificate and number and firm name to be painted on each side of all service trucks, in letters not less than 3" high, was also discussed.

Public Hearing was closed.


