

NOVEMBER 21, 1963

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Thursday, November 21st, 1963 at 1:30 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman W. E. Crist, acting Chairman in the absence of E. A. Bibey, Chairman.

PUBLIC HEARING was opened for the purpose of considering amendments and changes to the Southern Standard Building Code, 1960-1961 Edition.

Roy Snyder, spokesman for a committee of Independent Contractors, referred to a petition previously presented to the Board requesting that action of August 19, 1963, adopting amendments to the Southern Standard Building Code, be rescinded. He again presented a list of contractors who requested the Board to rescind action of August 19, 1963.

The main objections were to increase in amount of Building Contractors' bonds and increase in fees for renewal of Certificates of Competency. These objections were discussed at length.

Mr. Clark objected to the meeting being adjourned without a decision.




Meeting was declared adjourned.
