The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bibey, who stated that this was a Special Meeting of the Board, called to adopt a Proclamation and Resolution.

Mr. Crist stated that in this time of grave national tragedy, the assassination of our Chief Executive, the President of the United States, it was deemed most appropriate that this Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, pass a resolution of sympathy and condolences and dispatch it expeditiously to the bereaved family of our late President.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, and seconded by Mr. Crist, that such a resolution be adopted and spread upon the Minutes of this Board. Motion was carried unanimously.




Upon motion, the meeting was adjourned until Tuesday, November 26th, 1963 at 1:30 P. M.

R E S O L U T I O N .

WHEREAS, the people of Manatee County, Florida, are shocked and grieved at the death of our President of the United States of America while engaged in a sincere and conscientious effort to carry out the duties of his great office; and

WHEREAS, the people of Manatee County, Florida, desire to confey to the family of the President their sincere sympathy and condolences;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, in open session, on behalf of the people of said County, that the shock and grief prevailing here as a result of the tragic death of our President of these United States of America, John Fitzgerald Kennedy, have caused us to hesitate and reflect - to search our hearts - and to realize with sadness the loss of this great world leader - this man of courage - not only to our County, State and Nation, but to all mankind;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That out of our great respect for this man and his office, Monday, November 25, 1963, be proclaimed an official day of mourning in this County and all public agencies be closed, and it is recommended each person attend a memorial worship service in accordance with his belief.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That this resolution be spread on the Minutes of this body and a copy hereof be forwarded to the bereaved family of Mr. Kennedy along with our reverent prayers that God may grant them peace and understanding and strength to bear their burdens.
