GRANT AGREEMENT, SARASOTA-MANATEE AIRPORT AUTHORITY

Richard Wolfe, manager of the Sarasota-Bradenton Airport, explained that as a prerequisite for Federal aid in connection with the improvements proposed for the Airport under Project No. 9-08-037-C504, it was necessary for the Manatee County and Sarasota County Boards of County Commissioners and the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority to enter into and execute Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Agency. He explained further that the Agreement had been approved and executed by Sarasota County and the Airport Authority.
