TRAILER ESTATES FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT EXTENSION BOUNDARY LINES DEFEATED

The Board received, from the Clerks and Inspectors of the respective precincts, Certificates of Results of the Special Election held on the 27th day of July, 1965, on the question of extending the boundary lines of the Trailer Estates Fire Control District to include Whitfield Estates and Ballentine Manor Subdivisions (House Bill 2397, Acts of Florida 1965), as follows:

PRECINCT 29, WHITFIELD-BALLENTINE CIVIC CENTER

PRECINCT 35, TRAILER ESTATES
