AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
 APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL GRANT

Motion was made by Mr. Hutches that the Board submit application to the United States Government- Department of Health, Education and Welfare of the United States of America - (under provisions of Section 4 of Public Law 88-206) for air pollution control program grant to Manatee County, and that Resolution be adopted authorizing the appropriate officers of Manatee County to execute the application. SUNSHINE SKYWAY
 REQUEST RELOCATE SOUTH TOLLGATE

Motion was made by Mr. Briggs that Resolution be adopted requesting the State Road Department and the Florida Industrial Commission to give consideration to relocating the present south toll gate on the Sunshine Skyway farther to the northwest in order to permit a greater utilization by the public of certain beach and recreational areas without the necessity of paying the bridge toll. Motion was seconded by Mr. Clark and carried.
