The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, reconvened as the Board of Equalization in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Tuesday, August 16th, 1966 at 9:06 A. M.

The Board received Complaints and heard testimony regarding assessed valuations as follows:

No. 10 Champion Homes Builders Company
Represented by Charles J. Heil

No. 12 Phillips Petroleum Company
Represented by Troy Mason, tax agent for the firm.
(Lands purchased had been leased back to former owners for agricultural purposes).
V.F. Roberts stated he was leasing a parcel sold to Phillips Petroleum Company for cattle grazing until such time mineral operations are started.
(Leasing for payment of taxes).

No. 13 Martha Sue Taylor (Present)
Re: Service station located on highway being bypassed by re-location of U.S. 41 (rerouting).

No. 14 Robert L. Parry (Present)
Re: Bradenton Manor, a Presbyterian Retirement Home, being classified as tax exempt institution. (Decision by local and appellate courts not tax exempt and case now in Supreme Court).
Mr. Parry was instructed to file a formal written complaint so that it could be determined if this was a matter for the Board of Equalization.
