The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Friday, January 23, 1970 at 10:00 A. M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Fortson.

PUBLIC HEARING: AMENDMENT TO POLLUTION CODE

The Chairman declared Public Hearing open to consider a proposed amendment to the Manatee County Air and Water Pollution Control Code, recommended by the Pollution Control Board, and advertised in accordance with provision of Chapter 67-1671, Florida Statutes.

Randolph Snell, chairman of the Manatee County Air and Water Pollution Control Board, and Chris Angelidis, Sanitary Engineer, were present.

The proposed amendment was read by Mr. Boylston.

There were no objections, and the Chairman declared the Public Hearing closed.

AMENDMENT TO POLLUTION CODE: ADOPTED

Mr. Boylston read a proposed Resolution approving and adopting the amendment as recommended.

Mr. Hutches moved for the adoption of the Resolution, as read by the County Attorney, amending the Manatee County Air and Water Pollution Control Code by adding the following provision:

The standards set forth in this code shall be deemed supplemental to any applicable regulations of the State of Florida, and nothing contained in this code shall be deemed to excuse any person from compliance with such State Regulations.

Motion was seconded by Mr. Dierks and carried unanimously.
