LAWRENCE AMBULANCE SERVICE - SUPPLEMENT

The County Attorney read a proposed resolution providing for an additional supplement of \$4,500 to Lawrence Ambulance Service, Inc., which had been authorized by motion in the regular meeting of July 14, 1970.

Motion was made by Mr. McClure that the Resolution be adopted after amendment that the funds are to be used solely for current operating expenses and that Lawrence Ambulance Service, Inc., be required to submit a daily operating statement during the remainder of the term of the September 1968 Agreement. Motion was seconded by Mr. Dierks and carried unanimously.

NORTH MANATEE COUNTY DRAINAGE
 RE: RAILROAD FACILITIES (PORT)

Motion was made by Mr. McClure that the Chairman be authorized to execute a letter to the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company advising that Manatee County will meet its obligation to assume two-thirds cost of installation of three 72-inch pipe lines to be installed under the railroad at Piney Point to provide drainage for North Manatee County Watershed area. Motion was seconded by Mr. Hutches and carried unanimously.
