**VOTING MACHINE BUILDING (STORAGE): BID ACCEPTED**

Assistant County Engineer, Ken Foster, and Douglas E. Croll, Architect, were present with recommendations for awarding bid for the construction of the Voting Machine Storage Building to the low bidder, Chennault, Inc. Completion date was scheduled for 180 days. They advised that the building will be three and on-half feet above ground level, which would be level with the trucks for easier loading and unloading of the machines.

CHENNAULT, INC., in the amount of \$80,219.00
