SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, met in SPECIAL SESSION in the Court House in Bradenton, Florida, Thursday, October 10, 1974 at 9:40 A. M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Burton.

ZONING: SCHEDULE OF FEES

Art Fischer, Planning Director, submitted Z-93 AMENDMENT TO MANATEE ZONING ORDINANCE, approved as amended in the meeting of October 8, 1974, relating to Schedule of Fees. The amendment to (A) Z-93 provided for applicants for DRI to pay \$500.00 and other regular fees, plus actual cost of reporter and actual cost of transcript of proceedings when deemed appropriate by the Planning Commission.

Mr. Fortson moved for the adoption of a Resolution approving and adopting Z-93 Amendment to the Manatee County Zoning Ordinance as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. Dierks and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dierks, who is a member of the Executive Board of the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council, advised that the applicant for Development of Regional Impact is not allowed by the Chairman to be recognized during discussion in their Board meetings to justify or defend his application. He requested that a Resolution be drafted suggesting that the applicant be allowed to state his case.

There was no objection to recommendation by Mr. McClure that the County Attorney develop such a resolution for consideration by this Board.

PARKS & RECREATION - FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

John Marble, Parks and Recreation Director, submitted memorandum from the Department of Natural Resources regarding amendment to the Florida Boat Registration and Safety Law (Chapter 371, Florida Statutes), which will return to counties portions of motorboat registration fees collected. The returned funds are for the purpose of providing recreational channel markings, boat launching facilities and other boating related activities. He requested permission to file application for these funds and that he be appointed liaison officer for this project.

It was recommended that he check the records to clarify if he had been appointed liaison for the Department of Natural Resources or if he had to be appointed to each project, then the Board would take appropriate action.
