The meeting was called to order by Chairman Driggers, who stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider proposed budget amendments for Manatee County for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1976 and ending on September 30, 1977, as outlined in Summary Statement included in public notice published in the Bradenton Herald on May 29, 1977.

The Chairman declared public hearing opened for the purpose of hearing requests and complaints concerning said proposed amended budget.

BUDGET AMENDMENTS

Mr. Ashley and Mr. Marlar explained the proposed budget revisions to allow increase in Revenues (Receipts from Federal, State and County Sources, including actual cash carryover) and Expenditures in the following funds:

General Revenue	68,000.00

There were no objections to the proposed Budget Amendments and the Public Hearing was declared closed.

Motion was made by Mr. Fortson that Budget Amendments to the 1976-1977 Budget be approved as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. McClure and carried unanimously. **RECORDED S-2-104**


MEETING ADJOURNED
