COURT HOUSE ANNEX ADDITION - ARCHITECT AGREEMENT

The County Attorney presented Standard American Institute of Architects Agreement, with modifications, with Jerry N. Zoller, for architectural services on the addition to the Manatee County Court House Annex (Tax Collector/Property Appraiser Offices). Total cost of services not to exceed \$4,999. Referred to Mr. Zoller for review of the modifications.

208 WATER STUDY - TAMPA BAY REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL (TBRPC)

Representatives of the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council:
Scott Wilson, Regional Director; Ron Armstrong, Project Engineer; and Charles Howell, Environmental Planner; made presentation on the 208 Water Study, a Federally Mandated Water Quality Management Program, adopted under the Clean Water Act of 1972, aimed at making all waters, nationwide, swimable and fishable by 1983.

A condensed version of the two-volume study was distributed to the Board Members and the findings discussed as they pertain to Manatee County. The study shows the County has good water quality and set forth as the prime goals (1) pollution prevention, and (2) protection of water quality in reservoirs. Activities and implementation schedules to achieve these goals were reviewed.

Mr. Driggers stated that after TBRPC officially adopts and submits the Plan to the County, a work session will be held with Agencies that have been reviewing the Plan.

COURT HOUSE ANNEX ADDITION - ARCHITECT AGREEMENT

Following review of the terms and conditions set forth in the modifications, the contract was submitted signed by Jerry N. Zoller, Architect/Planner; Sam Cornwell, Tax Collector; and Archie Powell, Property Appraiser.

Motion was seconded by Mr. Fowinkle and carried unanimously.
