ZONING ATLAS AMENDMENT - RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK DISTRICT

Public hearing was opened for the purpose of receiving oral and written comments on proposed Text Amendment to Section 203(H) R-5, Recreational Vehicle Park District of the Manatee County Comprehensive Zoning and Land Development Code (referred to as Z-82-33). (Notice published in the Bradenton Herald August 11, 1982)

MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE Z-82-33: AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MANATEE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TEXT OF MANATEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE; AMENDING SPECIFICALLY SUBSECTION 203-H THEREOF, CONCERNING THE RESTRICTIONS AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE IN THE R-5 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Planning Director advised the only change in the text since the public hearing on August 2, 1982, is the combination of paragraphs 2b and 2c on page 11, to simplify the language.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion was made by Mr McGavic to adopt Zoning Ordinance Z-82-33. Motion was seconded by Mr Fletcher and carried unanimously.
