9TH CENT GASOLINE TAX

Mr Chance relayed request by gasoline retailers in the County that the Board delay collection of the 9th cent gasoline tax revenues for fifteen days (from October 1st) to allow them time to complete necessary preparation to implement collection of the additional revenue.

Phil Davis, Transportation Director, did not recommend a delay.


The County Attorney recommended the Board not deviate from the resolution (1/19/82) placing the tax on referendum and establishing the effective date of October 1, 1982.
