ORDINANCE 82-25 (PROPOSED) - CORTEZ PENINSULA THOROUGHFARE AMENDMENTS

The second public hearing (published in The Bradenton Herald 11/22/82) was opened for the purpose of considering amendments to the Manatee Plan to provide on the Major Thoroughfare Plan a system of minor collectors in Cortez and to designate specific inter-sections on the Peninsula (Proposed Ordinance 82-25).

Carol Clarke, Planning Department, informed the Board that revisions had been made in accordance with instructions to staff at the first public hearing on November 29th (the loop road to be reinstated at 42nd Avenue West and 126th Street West).

Mr Fletcher announced a meeting will be held with the citizens of the Cortez area, Tuesday, December 14, 1982 at 7:00 p.m., at the Manatee County Utilities Department complex, to inform them of the plans.

Richard R. Juett, 9535 Azure Cove, deferred his comments until the meeting of December 14th.

Mr Fletcher moved that this public hearing be continued to Tuesday, December 21, 1982, at 2:00 p.m. Motion was seconded by Mr Chetlain and carried unanimously.
