**SARASOTA-MANATEE AIRPORT AUTHORITY**

Barbara Levin, Assistant County Attorney, advised that the purpose of this Special Meeting is to request authority to intervene in the Appeal taken by the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) of the development orders issued by Sarasota County and the City of Sarasota regarding the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority.


Philip Parsons, representing the County in the appeal of the Manatee County denial of the development order and Special Permit, advised that stipulations being agreed upon between DCA and Sarasota County and the City of Sarasota regarding the traffic improvements do not appear to be adequate to protect the interests of Manatee County residents.

Mr. Hagaman moved to authorize the intervention of Manatee County in the appeal taken by the DCA of the development orders issued by Sarasota County and the City of Sarasota related to the Sarasota-Manatee Airport Authority. Motion was seconded by Mr. Chetlain and carried unanimously.
