The meeting was called to order by Chairman Fletcher.

IMPACT FEES

Public hearing (continued from June 25, 1986) was reopened for the purpose of considering

ORDINANCE 86-09 AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 81-4, THE MANATEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO PROVIDE FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF IMPACT FEES FOR ROADS, PARKS, SOLID WASTE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR ALL INCORPORATED AND UNINCORPORATED PARTS OF MANATEE COUNTY.

Upon question, The County Attorney, stated that wording on the issue relating to University Parkway in Section 102G, Credits (Scope) has been discussed with the Sarasota County Attorney but is not included in the ordinance. He recommended adoption of the ordinance in its present form and to set a date for a public hearing on amendments.

Carol Clarke, Planning & Development, pointed out that Commissioners' copies do not reflect correction of summary figures on page 31 relating to Parks & Recreation fee for Hotel/Motel to read 508, 594, 594, and 594. The original to the Clerk is correct.

Motion was made by Mr. Chance, and seconded by Mr. Chetlain, to adopt Ordinance 86-09. The County Attorney recommended that the motion be "to adopt Ordinance 86-09 as amended by interlineation this morning". Motion carried unanimously.


