HURRICANE GEORGES - STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

The meeting was opened to consider rescinding the state of local emergency (Resolution R-98-254, 9/24/98) by adoption of Resolution

R-98-256 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TERMINATING THE STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY.

Karen Windon, Public Safety Director, gave a status report on public response during hurricane Georges and commended County employees for their actions.

Mrs. Glass referred to a letter from the Sarasota Herald-Tribune (Manatee AM newspaper) praising the County's response and cooperation with the media during the hurricane.

Discussion: Intergovernmental communications; MGA TV coverage of hurricane; advance warning and preparation; cooperation between jurisdictions; level of expertise, etc.


